III. EXERCISE: assemblage

Through this week we will be working very directly. Please form teams of two students; We can consider groups of three but this may be more difficult for you.

There is almost no time for 'the eraser'. So making becomes very immediate: What you make in-process, in sketch and model, will be collected in the final result.

A single AO Tavolo will be the compilation, the representation of your Rifugio.

Each team will use mixed media, in collage form:

-Material (or found object)

-Text: the key word, or other description, manifest in design

-Drawings:

-Model:

This may be a sketch model (crude, rough).

Compose the model as part of the Tavolo, not a separate object -Site topography may be abstracted, simplified as major planes (it is not necessary to build each contour layer)

-Site base is to be dark, or grey

-The Rifugio should 'read' against this background

-Other:

Photos, etc.

We will work on composing this. Look at Christo drawings and material montages for inspiration. There is a sense of vision and energy. It may look 'unfinished'—that is OK.
